

Cap Go Meh Singkawang

February 10-24, 2024

Singkawang, West Kalimantan

The Cap Go Meh Singkawang is the culmination of the Chinese New Year celebrations held annually on the 15th day of the first month of the Chinese calendar or two weeks after Chinese New Year. It represents the peak of these festivities, featuring the grand parade of Tatungs, who serve as intermediaries embodying the spirits of gods. These Tatungs, whether walking or carried, perform various acts believed to expel evil spirits from the city. This festival, the largest of its kind in Indonesia, is a testament to the rich cultural heritage of the region.

In preparation for the event, the *Tatungs* have prepared themselves by fasting for eight days beforehand to ward off misfortune and for the spirits of the ancestors to enter the *Tatungs*. On the day before Cap Go Meh, the Tatungs perform *Cuci Jalan* (street cleansing) to avoid and expel unwanted things.

Last year, the festival took place on Jalan Diponegoro, with the Tatungs gathering on Jalan Firdaus before parading to Jalan Ponegoro. However, this year's festivities will only occur at the temples (Pekongs) as it is coinciding with the regional head election period.

This captivating event, steeped in tradition and spirituality, promises to be a vibrant celebration that is not to be missed.



Pesta Kesenian Bali

m June 15 - July 13, 2024

🕈 Denpasar, Bali



As the largest, most enduring, and most celebrated grassroots art event in Bali, the Pesta Kesenian Bali (PKB) has emerged as a space for the actualisation of sublime values and local culture-based arts. It has also become a catalyst for transforming Bali's way of life and life doctrines to align Bali as the center of world civilisation (Bali Padma Bhuana).

PKB XLVI in 2024 carries the theme of *Jana Kerthi:* Paramaguna Wikrama (Superior Human Dignity), which is interpreted as an effort to ennoble life and human life through niskala-sekala (subtle-tangible) efforts to realise the dignified, excellent and advanced human quality of life. PKB will feature traditional and classical arts, local community-based arts, as well as Balinese craftsmen or Creative Industry actors from the Regencies/Cities of Bali.

PKB is also a means of education and development of art creativity, encouraging active participation to directly learn and practice various branches of Balinese art through workshops and seminars.



may 31 - June 2, 2024

Central Jakarta, DKI Jakarta



Semasa Piknik is a Semasa activity that combines the creative economy, cultural arts practitioners, and history communities with a picnic theme in Jakarta. With green open spaces resembling picnics in a park, Semasa aims to be a one-stop community event to provide entertaining shopping experiences in the style of Indonesia's creative world.

With support from creative community groups, Jakarta walking tour operators, and support from JXB (Jakarta Experience Board), Semasa becomes a forum for communities with local creative ideas packaged in a modern style to attract Jakartans, domestic tourists, and foreigners.

In 2024, it is projected that the picnic experience at Semasa Piknik can be livelier and become a new Indonesian destination, located in the heart of Jakarta.



F8 Makassar

July 24-28, 2024

Makassar, South Sulawesi



The Makassar International Eight Festival & Forum (F8 Makassar)) is an event that brings together the diverse artistic, cultural, and culinary offerings of Indonesia in a vibrant celebration of Food, Fashion, Fusion, Music, Film, Fine Art, Fiction Writers, Folks, and Flora Fauna festival in Makassar. For cultural art and culinary workers, this is the "Creative Industries Biggest Festival".

In 2024, F8 Makassar adopts the theme "The Unity," building upon the previous year's theme of "The Next Gen Treasure." This theme underscores the convergence of diverse languages, cultures, and differences among various tribes, religions, and nations at F8 Makassar. It signifies the realisation of Bhinneka Tunggal Ika (Unity in Diversity) in its true essence.

Moreover, this year's performances will prominently showcase the cultural patterns of Nusantara, the archipelago, amalgamated through an original contemporary art process. The focus will be on the originality of the Betawi tribe, who settled in Makassar and integrated with Bugis Makassar traditions. Additionally, the traditions of the Batak tribe, which share cultural similarities with the Toraja tribe, will also be emphasised, emphasising the unity of Nusantara and the global community at the F8 Makassar event.



Jember Fashion Carnaval

m August 2-4, 2024

The Jember Fashion Carnival (JFC) is a cultural and local creator creativity-based carnival art performance, involving costumes and fashion inspired by *Nusantara* (Indonesian) culture, making it attractive to both domestic and foreign tourists. The fusion of creative fashion values in the carnival parade will take place along a 3.6 km road, involving all models and talents without discrimination.

In 2024, JFC takes the theme of "Algorithm" with the philosophy of the journey that must be taken by having a goal to solve problems in life. By presenting ten parades: Wayang, Chess, Versailles, Zodiac, Angel, Jember 2045, Betta Fish, Rio, Climate, and Media, the depiction of Algorithms becomes increasingly interesting every year.

JFC will be held at the Central Park of Jember, a town square located precisely to the north of the Jember Regent's Office. Surrounded by many icons and important buildings, such as Jami al Baitul Amien Mosque, Post Office, Class IIA Jember Correctional Institution, and various other buildings makes this a strategic location.

Festival Budaya Lembah Baliem

m August 7-10, 2024

Jayawijaya Regency, Papua Highlands



The 32nd Festival Budaya Lembah Baliem is an event showcasing cultural attractions aimed at promoting Wamena as a tourism destination (a regional promotional icon) for domestic and international tourists.

This festival will feature the traces of the ancestors' civilisation of the Hubula tribe through colossal war attractions, youth sports games (sikoko and puradan) that sharpen spear throwing skills, pig racing, Bakar Batu attraction (traditional cooking with stones), and performances of dances and traditional music Pikon.

The festival's pinnacle showcases the vibrant cultural carnival attractions of Nusantara, serving as a testament to the love for the nation and commemorating the 79th Anniversary of Independence Day of the Republic of Indonesia.



Festival Pacu Jalur

🛗 August 21-25, 2024

Q Kuantan Singingi Regency, Riau



The Festival Pacu Jalur is one of the annual tourism events in Kuantan Singingi Regency and has been held for more than a century. Pacu Jalur is one of the cultural traditions inherited by the ancestors of the Kuantan Singingi community and is the only one in the world.

Not forgetting the lively atmosphere and virality that occurred last year, Pacu Jalur has a dance master, a figure who can be said to be the icon of each boat. The dance master is usually a child who has good body balance, because when his boat wins, the dance master will usually stand at the front of his boat while celebrating.

Pacu Jalur is not just a competition, but is also one of the steps in advancing the economy. With the theme "Advance Tourism, Increase Economy, Prosper Society," Pacu Jalur is also enlivened by cultural parades, begulang and peragu begandung processions, cultural festivals, art performances, traditional music and art festivals, as well as MSME bazaar and exhibition.



Dieng Culture Festival

m August 23-25, 2024

Panjarnegara Regency, Central Java



The Dieng Culture Festival, also known as the Dieng Festival, is a performance that combines the natural beauty, uniqueness of culture, and traditions in the Dieng Plateau. The Dieng Culture Festival is held to develop village potential through community-based tourism, preserve traditional arts and local cultures, develop rural creative industries through performances, and help financially disadvantaged *gimbal* (dreadlocks) children. Uniquely, the Dieng Culture Festival will have a series of *gimbal* haircuts enlivened by art performances, Jazz On The Clouds, and a lantern release in the Dieng Plateau

The Dieng Culture Festival 2024 takes the theme "Journey of Culture" and will be held in August, precisely in the exotic month when Dieng sometimes reaches 0 degrees Celsius, creating an atmosphere like Europe. Dieng Culture Festival will take place at the Kompleks Candi Arjuna, an iconic tangible cultural heritage site in the form of temples that have collaborated with the community's intangible ritual culture, namely gimbal haircuts.



Wayang Jogja Night Carnival

October 7, 2024

The Wayang Jogja Night Carnival (WJNC) has become Yogyakarta's leading event held to commemorate Yogyakarta's Anniversary on October 7 every year.

WJNC is a street carnival which has been consistently organised since blending the theme of wayang (traditional carnival puppetry). The features choreographed performances, elaborate costumes. contemporary music. captivating lighting displays. Over time, the carnival concept evolved into street art while retaining the core elements of WJNC, including the iconic Tugu Jogja (Jogja Monument), decorated vehicles, and the incorporation of wayang puppetry. Held at night, WJNC showcases a carnival with a street art concept, drawing inspiration from the folklore stories of wayang puppetry, with participation from 14 Kemantren (subdistricts) in Yogyakarta.

Wayang Jogja Night Carnival #9 in 2024 will carry the theme of Gatotkaca Wirapraja, a collection of stories featuring the character of Gatotkaca. The character of Gatotkaca is a figure who can be emulated as a brave and gallant figure with a high spirit of defending the nation. In addition, Gatotkaca is also very well known and can be called an Indonesian Local Hero.

Similar to previous years, WJNC #9 will collaborate with art communities, MSMEs, and relevant agencies to provide more experiences for visitors through the "WJNC Fest".



Indonesian Contemporary Art & Design

October 10 - November 10, 2024

Indonesian Contemporary Art & Design (ICAD) bridges art and design, ranging from interior design, product design, architecture, visual communication, to other disciplines such as fashion, film, hospitality, technology, food and beverages, and many more. ICAD is the first and only platform that facilitates collaboration between various disciplines and becomes a large-scale exhibition that promotes contemporary design and art in Indonesia, while embracing the diversity of cultural expressions of the nation.

South Jakarta, DKI Jakarta

Each exhibition features multidisciplinary creative works, from senior contemporary artists to young creators, collectives, or communities engaged in art, design, music, culture, and new materials. Their works are divided into five categories: Special Appearance, In Focus, Featured, Open Submission, and Collaboration.



Aceh Ramadhan Festival



Pesona Hoyak Tabuik Piaman

The word "Tabuik" comes from the Arabic "Tabut" which means wooden hox or chest. A symbol commemorating the martyrdom of Hasan-Husein on the 10th of Muharram, Initially, Tabuik was held by the anak nagari in the form of Tabuik Adat (Tabuik Culture), but now it has become the Tabuik Tourism "Pesona Hoyak Tabuik Piaman" which has been recognised by the Local Government and included in the Calendar of Events (CoE) of Pariaman City. Every year, this event is held for 15 days, becoming the heart of West Sumatra tourism, a bond of closeness. cultural and community togetherness.

The series of Pesona Hovak Tabuik begins with the Mambiak Tanah Procession, Manabang Batang Pisang Maatam dan Maradai, Maarak Jari-Jari, Maarak Saroban, Tabuik Naik Pangkek, Mahovak Tabuik and ends with Tabuik dibuang ka Lauik (Tabuik being thrown into the Sea) at Gandoriah Beach. In addition to being a prime destination of Pariaman, this beach also has a historic meaning as the place for Tabuik release every year. During the event, visitors will enjoy handicraft bazaars, art and cultural attractions, traditional art competitions, talk shows about art and culture, as well as various other performances.

Sawahlunto International Songket Silungkang Carnival



The Festival Bakar Tongkang is a cultural celebration organised to honor the arrival of the Chinese community in Bagan Siapiapi in 1820.

This festival includes ritual burning of replicas of large ships as a symbol of generational tradition. The climax occurs when the ship mast falls, considered a sign to seek sustenance. Before the 400 kg giant ship is burned, the ship is stored in a temple to be blessed and later paraded around Bagan Siapiapi (Kirab Sang Thi Kong).

As well as the ship burning procession, this festival is also enlivened by the *Chia Thi Kong* Ritual, *Gemerlap Bagan* Art Performance, and Art Performance Night.



Jelajah Pesona Jalur Rempah (JPJR) East Belitung is an event designed to protect, develop, utilise, and foster culture as its spirit.



The Festival Sriwijaya 2024 carries the theme "The Spirit of Sriwijaya", with a series of events including Sendratasik Performance "The Spirit of Sriwijaya", Performing Arts from 17 Regencies and Cities in South Sumatra, South Sumatra Cultural Congress, Sriwijaya Writers Festival, Sriwijaya Youth Residency, Entertainment Stage, and MSME Exhibitions.


August 14-18, 2024

Palembang, South Sumatra

Palembang is one of the largest kingdoms in Indonesia, previously known as Sriwijaya. This has made Palembang have a quite long and interesting history. In the past, Palembang was also a trading route due to the existence of the Musi River which had become an economic center crossed by ships from various regions and the main means of transportation for the people of South Sumatra. One of these means of transportation is the Bidar Boat which is now one of Palembang City's local wisdom that deserves to be preserved.

Over time, this boat was raced by the people of Palembang and subsequently the race was organised by the Palembang Government. The traditional Bidar Boat Racing competition has finally become an annual event that is highly anticipated by the people. It takes place every Independence Day of the Republic of Indonesia as has been done for decades.

The 29-meter Bidar Boat will be rowed by 55 people, encouraged by two captains, who enliven the atmosphere. Aside from the race, various types of Bidar Boats will also be on display and there will be talks about Bidar Boats in order to introduce the local wisdom to the public which is now beginning to be forgotten. There will also be a parade of decorated motorboats that will circle the Musi River during the festival.

The Festival Budaya Sekala Bekhak is a space for artistic expression, a mirror to see oneself and the cultural wealth that needs to be interpreted, appreciated, and understood as a form of appreciation for the cultural heritage of the land where they are placed. With the slogan "See the Real Lampung", visitors are expected to be able to see and experience how Lampung culture began in the land of Sekala Bekhak.

In the 10th year of this event, traditional art performances will be the main focus at the Sekala Bekhak Cultural Festival, such as *Pitu Likukh* Night, *Ngelemang Bebakhong, Sekura* Dance Competition, Nyambai Festival, *Hadra "Ngeharak"* Cultural Arts Competition, Gambus Orchestra Festival as traditional arts, Kemilau Nusantara Cultures, "Sekala Bekhak Bercelugam" Fashion Show, and Kemilau Sekala Bekhak Land Cultures Carnival. As a form of support for Creative Economy in West Lampung, also there will be MSMEs/Handicraft Gala and Coaching Clinic.

The K-Fest (Krakatau Festival) 2024 carries the theme "Nemui Nyimah" which is one of the philosophical values of life that has been ingrained in the daily life of the Lampung Indigenous People. Nemui Nyimah is a local cultural wisdom concept to build quality tolerance, uphold politeness, to share, be generous and friendly to guests. It is a piil pesenggiri (pride) for them if the arrival of guests is served well. Nemui Nyimah is a philosophy for tolerance and nurturing harmony for the Lampung people.

Lampung Province known for its ethnic diversity, embraces and fosters friendships among its various ethnicities. The Krakatau Festival epitomises this spirit of collaboration, involving cultural communities, tourism stakeholders, the creative economy sector, academics, media, and regional governments. The Krakatau Festival series consists of Tourism and Creative Economy Festivals, Painting, Decorating and Creating Lampung Mask Competitions, Fashion Shows and Children's Art Performances, Nemui Nyimah Cultural Carnival, Night of Pesona Kemilau Krakatau, Krakatau Tour and Krakatau Run.





Tubaba Art Festival

The Tubaba Art Festival (TAF) is an annual cultural festival of Tubaba residents that showcases various artistic expressions. such as theater, dance, music, visual arts. crafts, literature, and film. Not merely an activity that creates liveliness, TAF is a method to increase and introduce the philosophy of Tubaba, which is "Nemen, Nedes dan Nerimo (Nenemo), meaning Working Hard, Resilient and Sincerely accepting God's gift" and "Setara, Sederhana, dan Lestari (SSL), meaning Equal, Simple, and Sustainable" in the process of creating and presenting every work of art. The embodiment of this has ultimately given rise to the label "Festival of Awareness", where in addition to showcasing artworks, it constantly holds supporting activities for the development of public knowledge and the development of residents' economy, such as workshops, public discussions. **MSMEs** and exhibition



West Tulang Bawang Barat Regency, Lampung



On this eighth edition, TAF will be held by continuing the final trilogy theme "Self and Space" with increasingly intensive collaborative work. The selection of the "Festivity in the Kitchen" subtheme envisions the disappearance of spatial and psychological distances between artists, who are local (Tubaba residents) and visiting artists. This collaboration involves students of the Tubaba School of Arts, residents, and artists from various regions in Indonesia and abroad. The selection of ideas and creative processes are carried out democratically, prioritising equality of position of each subject, one of which is through knowledge sharing methods.

Seba Baduy

m May 16-19, 2024

Seba is a word from the Baduy language which means offering. In the context of the Seba Ceremony, the Baduy community (Urang Kanekes) will offer the harvest yields to the Government. Based on history, the Baduy community has conducted Seba for hundreds of years, precisely during the glorious era of the Banten Sultanate. This tradition also manifests the loyalty and obedience of the



Baduy Tribe to the Government.

With the theme "Baduy Culture Diversity", it is hoped that Baduy culture can be world highlighted to the uniqueness and blended contemporary performing arts, but still maintaining the sacredness of the Seba ritual. Supporting events such as the Camping Ground, Traditional Games, Contemporary Art Spaces, and others will make the 2024 Seba Baduy an event destination that can enrich visitors with experiences and education about Baduy.

Q Lebak Regency, Banten



The Seba ceremony can be interpreted as the Baduy community's official visit after the harvest season. Seba is preceded by the Kawalu ceremony, which is an expression of thanks to God for the success of the harvest. In general, Seba has the purpose of hopes for safety and expressions of gratitude. This ceremony is carried out to bring the mandate of Pu'un (customary head), submit reports, convey hopes, and deliver the crops.



Festival Seni Multatuli

September 13-15, 2024

The Festival Seni Multatuli (FSM) 2024 or Multatuli Arts Festival carries the theme "Journey of Multatuli's Land Cultures" which is interpreted as efforts to explore and approach the cultural heritage of the past as well as showcase various regional art performances that can entertain through various events.

This theme also refers to a Water Buffalo. Water buffalo and farmers are two main things expressed by Multatuli in Max Havelaar. Through water buffaloes and farmers, Multatuli uncovered the rotten practices of colonialism that occurred in his colonial land.

FSM 2024 will be adorned by the Multatuli Journey, an activity that invites participants to retrace the historical traces of Multatuli during his life in Rangkasbitung, dissect Multatuli's books, and re-examine past FSM symposiums, so visitors can follow up on what has been implemented and gain more experiences.

Seren Taun Kasepuhan Cisungsang

As a cultural event, Seren Taun has a unique packaging. On one side as a cultural identity that forms as the defense of the Kasepuhan Indigenous People, the other side as a cultural tourism object, Seren Taun is able to present unique attractions and entertainment for the wider community.

These two different things are ultimately packaged through culture promotion with local wisdom. This provides uniqueness with Seren Taun able to present customary traditions, local arts, customary rituals, even modern art performances that prove that Kasepuhan Cisungsang is adaptive to the dynamics of human cultural development.

The Seren Taun Cisungsang celebration consists of two main categories of events: traditional activities with fixed types and schedules, and supporting activities (side events) such as cultural performances, tourism showcases, and educational presentations for visitors. Such as Rasul Pare di Leuit, Bubuka, Traditional Pantun (rhyme poems), Balik Rendangan, Ngareremokeun, Tatamu Sumping in Cisungsang, discussions between Kasepuhan Residents and Government, and others.



The "Festival dan Gelar Budaya Hari Nelayan 2024" event is a concerted effort to actualise and cultivate concepts derived from various activities and performances conducted along the coast of Palabuhanratu. Its primary aim is to preserve cultural and traditional values inherent in the lives of fishermen.

This is done as a form of participation of fishermen and coastal communities in efforts to preserve and develop cultural wealth that can also support programs to develop southern coast tourism in Sukabumi Regency.

The core events are Traditional Rituals and Sea Rituals, carnivals and cultural performances, followed by various activities of the Palabuhanratu coastal community, such as traditional Babalang fishing competitions, Coastal Health Walk Beach Cleaning, Traditional Sports Competitions, Wayang Golek puppet theater, and Culinary Tourism Bazar & Expo.



Seren Taun Gelaralam (Ciptagelar)

October 5-6, 2024

Sukabumi Regency, West Java



Seren Taun is the closing event of the *Pamakayaan* (farming) year from the process of rice planting for one year, which becomes a tradition annually at the end of agricultural activities. A harvest festival of the Banten Kidul community, in this case Kasepuhan Gelaralam, which has been held since 656 years ago (1368 - 2024) and carried out as customary law and passed down from generation to generation.

Seren Taun is also a characteristic of the agricultural community's way of life that still maintains the original order in preserving ancestral culture and the peak event of all community farming activities in Kasepuhan, which is carried out at the Kasepuhan center with a grand ceremony to honor ancestors, with all forms of arts from the Buhun (old) to modern arts.

The Seren Taun Gelaralam 2024 will be held with a series of exhibitions of community works in the form of agricultural produce and handicrafts, parades of harvest results, Ngadiukeun ritual ceremonies, and various art performances on open stages, such as rengkong, angklung dog-dog lojor, jipeng art, masks, debus, gondang, and pantun buhun (old rhyme poems).

Rampak Genteng

Movember 11, 2024

Rampak Genteng is a triennial festival that marks the beginning of the Terracotta Music Festival in Jatiwangi. Starting in 2012, Rampak Genteng has become the 'lebaran' moment for the people of Jatiwangi, where thousands of residents jointly sound the roof tiles as a sign of agreement to build a new city identity of "Kota Terakota (Terracotta City)" in Majalengka which is based on local resources.

This event will be enlivened by various activities, including Rampak Genteng Reunion, Ceramic Musical Instrument Making Workshop, Bakar Berjamaah (ritual burning of musical instruments with thousands of residents participating in the ceramic musical instrument workshop), Music Composition Workshop, and Rampak Genteng Performances.

Grebeg Sudiro

This event reflects the acculturation of Javanese and Chinese cultures, as well as a reflection of the Sudiroprajan area as an example of interaction, a cultural site, and forum for potential cultural, social and economic exhibitions.

With the theme "United in Diversity", Grebeg Sudiro 2024 has several series of events starting with the *Umbul Mantram* procession in Sudiroprajan Village, followed by an Potential MSMEs Bazaar and Kali Pepe River Boat Tourism in the Pasar Gede and Kali Pepe River areas. The Cultural Carnival is the peak event of Grebeg Sudiro held at the main venue, the Pasar Gede area with a parade route circling the Sudiroprajan Village area.

This year, Solo Menari will be held at two sites, which are the Solo Safari Zoo and Sriwedari Park (Bonrojo). Both sites serve as a link between the past and present regarding the existence of zoos in the city of Solo. This event aims to mobilise the Solo Safari Zoo as a space for education and creativity, as well as Sriwedari Park (Bonrojo) as a space for historical education as Sriwedari Park, in the past, (1901-1972) was the first zoo in Solo.

With the theme "Dancing the Zoo", Solo Menari wants to encourage the public to foster care for and love animals as part of the balance of nature. It will even feature dance works inspired by animal movements such as the monkey dance, peacock dance, and others.

The slogan "Becik Ketitik, Keroncong Ketara" means the uniqueness of keroncong that will be tangibly visible. This event will collaborate with keroncong artists throughout Solo Raya and will start with keroncong competitions, exhibitions of MSMEs musical instrument industries, batik, fashion-based event activities (batik, henna tattoo, barber & hairstylist as well as nail art), city tour staycation packages, and culinary MSMEs areas of Keplek Ilat.

It encompasses 25 supporting events, including religious, cultural, and hobby community activities, as well as MSME exhibitions, fostering collaboration innovation advancement of Ponorogo's economy.

Festival Ronthek Pacitan

m July 15-17, 2024

Pacitan Regency, East Java

The word ronthek comes from the words "ronda and thethek", which is a bamboo musical instrument made by drilling holes and played by striking it. Originally, ronthek was only an annual activity when Ramadan arrived with the aim of waking up residents for sahur. In this event, ronthek is struck and combined with other traditional musical instruments such as gongs, saron, kenong, and gamelan and become an accompaniment for songs or dances.

With the theme "Suminaring Pacitan Kawentar", the Festival Ronthek Pacitan 2024 will be held simultaneously with a massive Exhibition of Creative Products and MSMEs that will showcase various products. In addition, this year's Festival will be open to the public, not only village and sub-district representatives, but also openly to all communities, art groups, and art studios from various areas.





Banyuwangi Ethno Carnival

IIII July 9-14, 2024

Panyuwangi Regency, East Java



The Banyuwangi Ethno Carnival (BEC) is a contemporary cultural performance packaged through a carnival of costumes inspired by different traditional themes each year.

In 2024, BEC carries the theme "The Revival of Village" which will highlight the potential of Banyuwangi's Tourism Villages to be introduced at the national and international levels. Unlike last year which took place during the day, this BEC will be held at night with a lighting visualisation concept along a 2.5 km street.



Eksotika Bromo

m July 27-28, 2024

Probolinggo Regency, East Java



Eksotika Bromo is a festival and cultural celebration held at the Bromo Sand Sea as a culmination of arts combined with the beauty of East Java nature.

Eksotika Bromo highlights three elements of human life, which are "Tengger and its Culture, Bromo and its Nature, East Java and its Arts". Just as Tengger has become the sublime character of simple humans who can enchant and comfort all that is not found elsewhere. *Meruwat* (to restore it to its original state) and *Merawat* (to care) for mountains is a natural ritual, it will bring a light in the darkness that never ends, it will bring blessings amidst unrestrained disasters.

The theme of Ruwat Rawat Segoro Gunung highlights the appreciation of Tri Hita Karana cherished by the Tengger Tribal Community, by Meruwat and Merawat for nature as a medium of living devotion to the Creator.

Eksotika will provide a spiritual experience through cultural expressions that blend with natural beauty.



Festival Gandrung Sewu

October 24-26, 2024

Panyuwangi Regency, East Java



Gandrung Sewu is a grand Gandrung dance festival in Banyuwangi Regency, East Java that has been held since 2012. Initially, the Gandrung Sewu Festival was held to introduce Banyuwangi's culture, especially Gandrung, to a wider audience. Now, Gandrung Sewu has become Banyuwangi's iconic cultural tourism icon and is held annually at Boom Beach with the Bali Strait backdrop.

This year, the Gandrung Sewu Festival carries the theme "Omprog: Art Towards Magnificence" which means an expression that reveals the social and moral values of how a Gandrung figure responds to magical phenomena in their lives with the awareness (self-control) they possess. Simply put, it is the struggle of thought and soul of the Gandrung figure who has been crowned during the Meras Gandrung ritual as a gandrung dancer.



Parade Surabaya Juang

Minimum November 1-3, 2024

Surabaya, East Java



The Surabaya Juang Parade has been held annually since 2008, in November, as part of the Heroes Day commemoration. This annual event involves more than 3,000 participants consisting of various community elements, such as veteran fighters, Regional Leadership Coordination Forum, historical communities, old bicycle communities, police, military, students, and various community members. Approximately 500 reenactors (history reenactors) from all over Indonesia will be involved in this event.

This event will pass through a route stretching approximately 2.5 km, starting from the Heroes Monument to the Youth Hall (Surabaya Town Square), presenting a parade themed on heroism; using heroic costume attributes, war vehicles, and others. There will also be collaborative displays at various points along the parade route including: theatrical battles of '45 attractions allied with musical performances and poetry readings. This route passes many historical sites and buildings as well as the colonial warfare route used seize independence of the Republic of Indonesia.

Gawia Sowa is a Dayak Bidayuh customary tradition to give thanks for harvest, health and security of the village community to the Almighty or *Jubata* and ancestral spirits believed to reside in mountains, forests and valleys. This event is held to preserve ancestral art and culture as cultural tourism attractions, such as rituals, dances, traditional houses, and the natural environment of the Dayak Bidayuh tribe in Jagoi Babang Village.

In this event, all invited guests will gather in the Traditional House and be served traditional food and drinks before the main event takes place. When all guests are present, there will be a ritual where several maidens and customary leaders will circle the traditional house while chanting prayers of gratitude to Jubata. Furthermore, all guests will have the opportunity to traverse the "Tangga Seribu (Thousand Steps)" to witness the pinnacle of the event.

Afterwards, at the Peak of Bung Kupu'ak Hill, performances will begin with various traditional dances as entertainment for guests, the "Sigal Paad Sadih" procession by offering sacrificial offerings to Jubata residing in the traditional house (Boni Pangah Bipokat), and continued with various typical Dayak Bidayuh performances.

The Festival Budaya Isen Mulang (FBIM) or Isen Mulang Cultural Festival has been held since 1993, and has introduced a variety of cultural attractions in Central Kalimantan, becoming an attractive event in society as well as helping to preserve local culture. This Cultural Festival is attended by representatives from 14 Regencies/Cities in Central Kalimantan.

FBIM has important meaning for the people of Central Kalimantan as a symbol of "meeting", an arena for creativity for local art practitioners based on existing cultural practices that live in every part of the Dayak community's life in Central Kalimantan.

This festival contains various competitive activities including Cultural Carnival, Selection of Tourism Prince and Princess, Traditional Arts, Traditional Games, Traditional Sports, Regional Culinary of the Dayak people of Central Kalimantan.



Festival Babukung

August 8-10, 2024

Q Lamandau Regency, Central Kalimantan

The Festival Babukung is a festival adopted from the Dayak Tomun death tradition. To provide material help while entertaining mourning families, the Dayak Tomun people were present dancing, wearing various *Luha* (traditional masks). Dancing with these masks is called "Babukung". The beauty of dance movements, uniqueness of musical rhythms, and exoticness of the masks are incorporated into a festival to preserve culture as well as encourage tourism in Lamandau Regency.

This year, the Festival Babukung carries the theme "Preserving Traditions, Caring for the Earth, Navigating the Digital Era". The Festival Babukung 2024 adopts a hybrid event concept, combining offline and online events. Highlights/various activities in this year's event include the *Luha* (traditional Babukung mask) carnival, performances of creative *Babukung* dances, ethnic music performances, photography exhibitions, workshops, MSMEs bazaar, photocompetitions, and colouring competitions.

Iraw Tengkayu







Pesta Adat dan Budaya Lom Plai

March 18 - April 23, 2024

Lom Plai is a ritual performed after the rice harvest and is only done once a year, and it has been carried out by generation after generation for decades. This performance is a form of gratitude and thanks to God for the abundant rice harvest, prosperity, and welfare of the community and is also a reminder of the sacrifice of Princess Long Diang Yung.

It is said that at that time a long drought occurred which resulted in crop failure and famine. At that time Boq Diang Yung received a revelation from the Creator to sacrifice her only daughter, Long Diang Yung, to save her people from disaster. With a heavy heart, Boq Diang Yung obeyed the order.

When her daughter was sacrificed as an offering, her blood flowed into the land and turned into rice plants that continued to increase to meet the needs of her people. Boq Diang swore that the descendants of the Dayak Wehea tribe must carry out Lom Plai to commemorate and remember the sacrifice of her daughter.

The traditional culture festival of Lom Plai will be enlivened with various traditional rituals and cultures. In addition, there will also be various art performances and traditional games, exhibitions and MSMEs bazaars with local wisdom themes, folk entertainment, and competitions.

Hudoq Pekayang

Hudoq Pekayang is a traditional cultural heritage inherited from generation to generation by the Dayak community in Mahakam Ulu Regency, as a form of togetherness, tolerance, mutual cooperation and consensus. All residents from 13 villages in Long Pahangai Subdistrict will gather in one event venue to jointly prepare the entire series of activities. In addition, there will also be mutual cooperation to renovate residents' buildings that need repair.

Hudoq Pekayang 2024 adopts the concept that one ancestral heritage can facilitate community togetherness and a spirit of mutual cooperation, thus creating a comfortable, peaceful and prosperous life. The event will be held in turns in the 13 villages according to customary deliberation agreements.

This year, the village of Long Isun gets their turn to host. For three days, there will be many performances, including the opening and joint dance, art performances, cultural festivals, art performances, traditional sports, customary deliberations, Catholic thanksgiving prayers as an expression of gratitude to God, and concluded with a farewell ceremony.

Balikpapan Fest is a highly anticipated event among the residents of Balikpapan, offering a diverse blend of culture, tourism, education, entertainment, community sports (sports tourism), and expos. In its fifth year with the theme "Nusantara Creative 2024," Balikpapan Fest features a plethora of activities including cultural festivals, culinary and MSME festivals, expos, talk shows, community sports events, and performances by both local and national entertainers.

The logo of the Semarapura Festival is Kayonan, which is a gunungan that appears in Balinese shadow puppet stories. Kayonan is considered the beginning or start of a story.



Nusa Penida Festival



Rimpu is the manifestation of covering female hair in the Bima era, it started to be used publicly and became part of the cultural heritage since the era of Bima Sultanate II in 1640 AD. *Rimpu* was usually worn when going out of the house or attending other sacred events. *Rimpu* also depicts the status of Bima women who wear it without using accessories like pins and hair clips.

Until now, the implementation of *rimpu* is still strongly upheld and has become a cultural heritage icon. That is why the Festival Rimpu Mantika is a source of pride for the people of Bima who always look forward to it. In 2024, this event will feature the Rimpu Mantika Dance for the first time. Not only that, there will also be performances of traditional arts such as *rawa mbojo*, *biola gambo*, creative economy bazaars, fashion shows, and there will be a Rimpu Mantika parade featuring a series of Rimpu Mantika Dances by 500 dancers as the highlight of the event.

Festival Perang Topat

The Perang Topat (Topat War) is part of the Lombok community's tradition to maintain religious tolerance and harmony between the two tribes and religions, which are the Sasak tribe who adhere to Islam and the Balinese tribe who adhere to Hindu. This event demonstrates the harmony of residents who embrace Islam and Hinduism by throwing topat (diamond-shaped rice cake) at each other without any clashes or confrontations. Perang Topat is an Intangible Cultural Heritage (ICH) that was nationally recognised in 2020.

This event has been held annually since the era of King Anak Agung Ngurah Karang Asem and the spread of Islam in Lombok. To this day, harmony is still reflected during religious rituals and at the Perang Topat event whose location has never changed, being held in Taman Lingsar, West Lombok Regency, West Nusa Tenggara.

m April 2-6, 2024

The Festival Bale Nagi emerged from the tradition of returning home (*Bale Nagi*) during *Semana Santa*, a unique and world-renowned religious ritual. In Portuguese, *Semana Santa* means Holy Week commemorating the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. The tradition of migration and returning home before Easter has been going on for centuries in the East Flores Regency.

This festival has become a medium for social bonding for the people of Nagi (indigenous people of Larantuka), all residents of East Flores Regency (Lamaholot tribe), and immigrant tribes living in East Flores Regency. Apart from migrants (diaspora), usually during Semana Santa, Larantuka City is flooded with tourists (pilgrims) both domestic and international.

Uniquely, the pilgrims are not only Catholics, but also from various religions and ethnicities. It is therefore no surprise that the Bale Nagi Festival is also a moment to introduce the diverse Lamaholot East Flores natural attractions and cultural arts.



Festival Pesona Kebangsaan

May 30-31, 2024

♀ Ende Regency, East Nusa Tenggara



Ende Regency, located in the center of Flores Island, East Nusa Tenggara, has a historical heritage tourism attraction closely related to the basis of the Republic of Indonesia, namely Pancasila.



The presence of Indonesia's first President's historical heritage in Ende is marked by the preservation of various existing sites. In fact, the formulation of Pancasila coined by Ir. Soekarno was actually inspired by his four years of exile in Ende from 1934-1938. A historical witness to the birth of Pancasila in Ende is the preservation of the *Sukun* tree (now the Pancasila Reflection Park), where Ir. Soekarno meditated during his exile.

Festival Pesona Kebangsaan 2024 will revive the theme "Soekarno and Pancasila" with an outline mapping Ir. Soekarno's Historical Heritage in Ende. Visitors can join the Sea Parade and Land Parade to visit various historical heritages of Ir. Soekarno, such as Soekarno Port, Military Police Office, Soekarno's Exile House, Soekarno Veranda, Mrs. Amsi's Grave, and Pancasila Reflection Park. There will also be a National Expo in the form of Regional Art Performances and MSME exhibitions.

Festival Golo Koe Maria Assumpta Nusantara

August 10-15, 2024

♥ West Manggarai Regency, East Nusa Tenggara



The Festival Golo Koe Maria Assumpta Nusantara expresses holistic tourism that is spiritual, cultural, economic, ecological and inclusive in dimension. This festival wants to involve and benefit the local community, and is rooted and growing in local culture and spirituality, as well as integrated with environmental conservation. This year's theme is Integral Ecology with the motto Harmony, Pedagogy and Prosperity.

The event will begin with an opening ceremony with an ethnic parade and colossal Manggarai Flores dance. There will then be an exhibition week involving MSMEs from all corners of Flores with the riches and uniqueness of creative economic products, a variety of unique and interesting local cultural arts attractions will enliven the festival days. Social charitable activities (aid) and ecologicalism delineate the humanitarian character and environmental conservation within the festival.

The highlight of the event is the Catholic religious procession and Maria Assumpta Nusantara Eucharist celebration that will involve various ethnicities of East Nusa Tenggara and Nusantara, as well as religious communities that live tolerantly together.

Festival Lamaholot

October 16-19, 2024

Lamaholot is one of the ethnic groups inhabiting the islands in the East Nusa Tenggara region. This ethnic group is spread across the Solor Islands which include Lembata Island, Solor Island, Adonara Island, the eastern part of Flores Island, and most of the Alor Archipelago region.

The unity of this ethnic group has become strong, thanks to the existence of the Lamaholot association outside the Lamaholot area, the use of the Lamaholot language as one of the transaction languages in markets, informal activities, and as a daily conversational language.

In this year, the Festival Lamaholot 2024 carries three strategic issues; Lamaholot Weaving, Sole Oha Literature (Lamaholot Language), and sea conservation based on local wisdom (muro dan badu). These things will be packaged in the following series of activities: Lamaholot Cultural Parade, Lamaholot Cultural Performances, Seminars and Workshops on Lamaholot Weaving, Lamaholot Economy Creative Exhibitions, Visits to Weaving Villages, Sole-oha Songs Literature, Visits to Customary Villages, as well as cultural rituals and attractions of Buka Badu and Muro conservation.

October 8-10, 2024




Gorontalo Karnaval Karawo

The Festival Pesona Pohon Cinta (FPPC) has been an annual event since 2017. Unfortunately, the COVID-19 pandemic resulted in this event not taking place in 2020 and 2021, so it only returned in 2022.

The philosophy of the Tree of Love is the community's expression of love for trees, especially mangroves growing around this tourism center.

FPPC is a form of community identity expression together with the Local Government aimed at educating, entertaining, and conserving through performances and articulating cultural heritage, as well as creative economy communities. In addition, FPPC also becomes a venue for promoting investment, community empowerment, economy, and outstanding local wisdom highlighting customs/traditions and local culinary. Various activities will be carried out at this event, such as dances and songs, multi-ethnic customary performances, creativity and culinary processing demonstrations. carnivals, MSMEs economy creative talk shows, and modern music presentations will be packaged with the nuance of "Duwo" or a type of fish.

The Coast of Tree of Love Beach is where fishermen's boats gather after harvesting duwo fish, a fish that only exists in every "Pate Lo Hulalo" (end of the month in the sky or dark moon). This fish was originally managed traditionally, both in terms of catching and cooking methods. However, it has experienced a shift due to technological and information developments. As a result, the current generation no longer knows the tradition of processing the duwo fish. More specifically in Pohuwato, the traditional processing that must be uncovered is the making of "Jepa lo Duwo" using "Tombe", a cooking utensil made from clay.

As an Eco Tourism Event, the Festival Teluk Tomini 2024 will hold various programs relevant to the theme and related issues, such as Environmental Arts, the Tomini Fashion Carnival, Traditional Performing Arts as well as Performing Arts of New Creative Arts, Multi-Ethnic Performing Arts, Exhibitions, Workshops & Forums, and others.



Festival Danau Poso

The Festival Danau Poso is an annual festival that in its implementation unites the various existing cultural and natural elements in the Poso Regency area. This includes traditional art performances, cultural exhibitions, and local music performances, cultural diversity, and various dances in Sulawesi.

The Festival Danau Poso 2024 carries the theme "Spirit of Molimbu (Limbayom Pombetirinai)" which aims to promote and celebrate the rich cultural heritage and traditions as well as the amazing natural environment around Lake Poso as one of Indonesia's leading tourist attractions.

This year, the Lake Poso Festival focuses on preserving the Molimbu tradition, which is the community's tradition of gathering and eating together in happiness and sorrow. *Molimbu* is an important symbol in every aspect of the life of the communities around Lake Poso by instilling the values of "Mombe Patowe" (caring for each other), "Mombe Patuwu" (enlivening each other), and "Mombe Tubunaka" (respecting each other).





Festival Tumbe

Every year on December 4th, the Batui Customary Community in Banggai Luwuk Regency, sends Maleo bird eggs as a symbol of the presence and sustainability of their culture to the Banggai Kingdom in Banggai. This tradition involves three regencies, namely Banggai Laut Regency, Banggai Regency, and Banggai Islands Regency.

The center for the traditional ceremony of delivering Maleo bird eggs is located at the Banggai Royal Palace in Banggai Laut Regency. The *Malabot Tumbe* tradition, which is still firmly upheld by the Batui and Banggai Customary Community, has become a cultural heritage that strengthens relations between regencies and preserves traditional values.

The Banggai Laut Regency Government also enlivens this series by holding the "Malabot Tumbe Customary Ceremony" attended by customary leaders, government officials, all elements of society, and students from throughout Banggai Laut Regency. The ceremony is enlivened with various activities, including performances of traditional music, Baode, Ridan and Toluni, traditional fishing, and grilled fish carnival.

In addition to music and dance performances, TIF will also hold exhibitions of handicrafts and exhibitions of Toraja and Nusantara's culinary specialties that will be filled by MSME associations and independent participants.

Since its inception in 2010, this event has played a crucial role in promoting tourism in South Sulawesi, particularly in Parepare, which has witnessed significant growth and development over the years.







The Timika Inside Festival of Art (TIFA) is a space for art practitioners in the land of Papua, especially in Timika, Central Papua, to showcase their individual works.



This festival has continued to strengthen local wisdom and culture in the Asmat Regency area since 1981. This festival presents an opportunity for artists in Asmat Regency to present and promote carving and weaving talents while improving their creative economy. The local wisdom includes wood carving art, handicrafts, songs, dances, and rituals that have a dialectical relationship with one another.

The 37th Festival Asmat Pokman will be expanded, to not only include carving art exhibitions, but also uplifting other local wisdom. For example, pangkur sagu (harvesting sago dance) and local culinary delicacies are presented to give weight to issues of local food security, Mangrove Trips to encourage ecotourism and protection of Asmat Regency's ecosystems, Creative Economy Talk Shows, Asmat Painting and Decoration workshops, and Asmat Art workshops.

The uniqueness of Festival Asmat Pokman is the manual carving demonstration that always attracts tourist attention as well as the parade of paddling boats where participants are in an upright standing position, shouting and responding, sprinkling white chalk from bamboo joints, beating boats with wooden paddles rhythmically, and forming formations in the middle of the Kelabu River.
